*For those who select departments of English Language and Literature, American Culture and Literature, German Language and Literature, German Translation and Interpreting, English Translation and Interpreting and Tourism Guide. Students who will select these departments have to take this exam. Foreign Language ProficiencyExam will be made for once only so candidates who didn't take this exam or didn't pass the exam shall lost their right to select these departments. Therefore, candidates are required to take this exam if they want to select these departments for 2.nd or 3.rd establishments.

1. Filling the Preference and Placement Form

1.1. Candidates who can apply for Preference

According to the article; 10.-(1) of the "Ege University Directive on the Principles of Admission of Foreign Students." provided that they are in the last year of high school or have graduated;

- (a) Those who are foreign nationals,
- (b) Those who are Turkish citizens by birth but lose their Turkish citizenship by obtaining permission from the Ministry of Interior to renounce their Turkish citizenship, and those who certify that they have a "Blue Card", which is given upon request to those who lost their Turkish citizenship, (Article 7 of the Turkish Citizenship Law No. 5901 "(1) within Turkey or a child born in marriage union with a Turkish citizen mother or father outside the country is a Turkish citizen.", because of this reason for candidates who will apply for admission quotas from abroad it is recommended to examine the Turkish Citizenship Law about their situation.)
- (c) Having a Turkish citizenship which acquired later while being a foreign national (Article 7 of the Turkish Citizenship Law No. 5901 states that "The child born in or out of Turkey to a Turkish citizen mother or father in a marriage union is a Turkish citizen. A child born to a Turkish citizen mother and foreign father outside the marriage union is a Turkish citizen". Since there are provisions at issue, those who have completed their secondary education in Turkey whose nationality is Turkish must prove that they are not Turkish citizens by birth -A document of "Certified Population Registration" which will be obtained from the Population Directorates of Turkish Government or etc.,(so Certified Population Registration or etc indicating that applicants got Turkish citizenship later while being a foreign national will requested from these applicants during the application period.)
- (d) The students of Turkish nationality who continued their secondary education abroad before 01/02/2013; and completed the last three years of their secondary education (high school) in a foreign country excluding the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus/TRNC (including those who completed all of their secondary education (high school) in a Turkish school opened by the Ministry of National Education in a foreign country other than the TRNC), can apply –

The students of Turkish nationality who started their education abroad after 01/02/2013; and completed their entire secondary education (high school) in a foreign country excluding the TRNC (including those who completed all of their secondary education (high school) in a Turkish school opened by the Ministry of National Education in a foreign country other than the TRNC) can apply, (in this context, the candidates who will apply should receive all of their secondary education, "excluding the pandemic period" in overseas schools face to face and they will be required to prove that education method)

(e) Those who are TRNC nationals, residing in the TRNC, and have completed their secondary education (high school) in the TRNC and have the General Certificate of Education at Advanced Level (GCE AL) exam results, and by enrolling and receiving education in colleges and high schools in other countries between 2005-2010. Applications of those who have or will have the "General Certificate of Education Advanced Level" (GCE AL) exam results (provided that they take the EGEYOS Exam) are accepted.

It is important for the candidates to carefully examine the application conditions and to review their nationality status which they entered in their application information. (Candidates with dual citizenship, who are foreign nationals by birth and later become Turkish citizens, must enter their foreign nationality into the system firstly.)

In case the student registration is not received due to incorrect entry of the nationality information, the responsibility arising will belong to the candidate himself.

1.2.Making a Preference Application

Candidates can make a preference with their "EGEYOS Placement Scores" of the year.

Candidates will apply for preference with the score they get from the relevant type of "EGEYOS Placement Score" according to the score type of the program they will choose.

In order to choose associate degree programs, it is sufficient to get at least 40 points from anytype of EGEYOS exam.

For undergraduate programs, candidates who score 40 points and above in the relevant EGEYOS placement score type according to the program they will choose, can apply.

Candidates who get 40 or more points from "Placement Score of EGEYOS Reasoning Type" can prefer education programs given in foreign languages like English Language and Literature, American Culture and Literature, German Language and Literature, Translationand Interpretation, Tourism Guidance and other Foreign Languages.

But these students must also be successful in "The Foreign Language Proficiency Exam" which will organize by Ege University School of Foreign Languages.

Otherwise, their preferences for these language programs will not be taken into account.

Candidates who want to study in programs that accept students with a special talent exam determined by OSYM (Sports Sciences Faculty programs, programs of the State Turkish Music Conservatory, Art Teaching program) must get 40 or more points from any type of EGEYOS exams in order to participate in the special talent examination. The candidates should also apply to the said school in person for the special talent test by following the related Faculty/School special talent test calendar.

Candidates should carefully examine the "List of Scoring Types and Special Conditions According To Program" while applying for preference. (It has been at the end of the page.) Because for registration in some kind of programs special conditions (such as physical spesifications like height or weight) are required. Candidates who do not meet these special conditions will not be able to enroll in the said departments.

Program preferences will be made online by the candidates via the

"https://ais.ege.edu.tr/login.php" website.

During the selection process, the candidate will enter the system with their candidate number and password (created during the application),

They will fill the preference form and choose the programs they will prefer.

After the online preferences session completed the selected programs will be seen and approved by the candidate from the end screen.

Candidates can change their preferences during the application period. When the application period expires, the selection process will be finalized and no changes can be made.

All candidates, including those who will prefer programs that require special abilities, will fill out the preferences form. However, candidates who will apply for a special talent program can choose for a maximum of five (5) separate programs, excluding programs that accept students with a special talent exam.

2. Procedure for Placement

Candidates are placed to programs according to a list descending from the highest grade within the quota of relevant department.

Placements are made to departments/programs according to regarding EGEYOS placement score type of the program except of programs which required special aptitude test.

Students are placed in departments/programs according to previously announced quotes basedon the 20% national qualifying threshold.

On the other hand, candidates with a "Blue Card" who apply to foreign student admission quotas, those who are Turkish citizens by birth and renounced their Turkish citizenship by obtaining permission from the Ministry of Internal Affairs, and those who have completed their high school education (for Turkish nationals who continue their secondary education abroad before 01/02/2013, the last three years of high school education)) for candidates with Turkish citizenship who have studied abroad (except for TRNC) / dual nationality, one of which is Turkish, in this situation, placement in Teaching, Law, Medicine, Dentistry, Pharmacy programs will be made by considering 10 percent of the quota of the aforementioned programs.

Candidates, one of whose preferences is a program admitting students with special aptitude tests are placed according to Blended Aptitude Grades composed of EGEYOS Exam and special aptitude test scores.

In the event that placement grades of two candidates are equal, placement is primarily based on secondary education achievement score and then the preference. If everything is still equal, the younger candidate is selected.

A candidate can only be placed in one department only. Therefore, candidates who placed in one department/program cannot apply for other establishments in that year. In case less students are admitted than quota allocated or in case of inadequate application, extra admission for the related quota may be applied and same procedure may be applied for athird time.

In the event that no applications are made or applications fall short of assigned quotas for a department, vacant quotas cannot be transferred to another department.

3. Registration Procedures

Candidates who do not apply for registration to the Registrar's Office within the registration period will lose their registration rights for that year. All registration procedures will be announced on our website www.oidb.ege.edu.tr.

The candidate will be responsible for the consequences that may arise due to the deficiencies and mistakes in the information they will enter in the Preference Forms.

Expenses like accommodation, transportation, stationery, etc. will be borne by the students.
